- Submissions required: legible score and parts (originals or copies), entry form, plus \$10 entry fee (via check payable to "VCU Jazz Students Fund"; nonrefundable). Limit one entry per person. ENTRY MATERIALS (scores, parts, recordings) WILL NOT BE RETURNED.
- Optional but highly recommended: live, studio, or synthesized demo CD (no cassettes).
- Submissions must be received by October 1.
- All works received are owned by the composers. However, VCU retains the copies received and has permission to perform and (if applicable) record them.
- Though a quality demo CD is preferable, entries will be judged on the merits of the composition itself, not on the submitted performance or audio quality.
- Results will be announced by December
 No winner need be chosen if the judges find that no entry merits the award.
